
Project Description

Wyssen USA Inc. will be installing 5 Wyssen Avalanche Towers near Rico, CO. The terrain is mountainous and rope access will be required at some of the sites. The work involves preparing the site by clearing soil and rock to create a flat spot. Then drilling boreholes for the anchors for the foundation. The anchor bars will be inserted into the boreholes and grouted in place. Then a concrete form must be constructed, and concrete poured. Finally, after the concrete has cured the towers must be mounted via helicopter.
